#### WHO ARE WE?


**The Glendora Education Foundation** is a nonprofit whose mission is to provide the best education possible for every student of the Glendora Unified School District.

The origins of the Foundation began in 2003, with a group of parents exploring the idea of working together to enrich education for the children in the Glendora Unified School District. Eager to put the idea into action, they formed a nonprofit organization to provide financial and volunteer support for all the schools in the District.

Since then, the Foundation has served as a liaison between the community and our schools, and is an effective channel through which the public can support the District's nine schools and 7,600 students. To date, the Foundation has raised and donated over \$4 million to Glendora's schools. These contributions have positively impacted schools by promoting many programs and services for all grade levels.



**School Based Campaign** Provides support for each school to receive 21st Century programs and tools they DO NOT HAVE or NEED MORE OF such as:
